Objective

To establish a robust grassroots ecosystem across India that promotes **early exposure**, **skill development**, and **long-term athlete engagement** in Roll Ball, particularly focusing on **children**, **youth**, **and underserved communities**. The program aligns with AIMS's core objectives of accessibility, inclusion, and structured sport growth at the foundational level.

1. School-Level Introduction Programme

Program Name: Roll Ball Shiksha Abhiyan

Description:

A national-level school outreach program designed to introduce Roll Ball as a fun, skill-building sport during school hours and as part of PE curriculum.

Key Activities:

- Demo sessions in collaboration with local education boards.
- "Try Roll Ball" starter kits distributed to schools.
- Training of school PE teachers to conduct regular sessions.

Target:

- Cover 5,000 schools by 2027.
- Introduce 500,000 children (ages 6–14) to Roll Ball.

2. Community & Slum Roll Ball Clinics

Program Name: Gully Roll Ball Clinics

Description:

Rolling weekend and holiday clinics in urban slums, villages, and peri-urban areas using community grounds and temporary equipment.

Key Activities:

- 2-hour fun skill sessions by RBFI grassroots coaches.
- Involvement of local volunteers and youth icons.
- Focus on affordability and engagement (free sessions, light gear).

3. Roll Ball for Girls Initiative

Program Name: Nari Shakti Roll Ball Mission

Description:

Special camps and incentives to promote Roll Ball among girls in schools, colleges, and rural communities.

Key Activities:

- All-girls introductory camps with female coaches.
- Mentorship by top national women players.
- Scholarships for talented girl players from low-income families.

Goal:

• Achieve 40% female participation across grassroots events by 2026.

4. Roll Ball Youth Academies & Mini Clubs

Program Name: RBFI Roll Ball Utsav

Description:

A weeklong nationwide celebration of Roll Ball featuring exhibitions, matches, workshops, and awards at the grassroots level.

Key Activities:

- Inter-school and inter-locality friendlies.
- Honor local grassroots coaches, volunteers, and clubs.
- Display of regional talent and community media coverage.

Goal:

• Activate 1,000+ locations across India during each annual celebration.

6. Roll Ball Coaches at the Base (RBCB) Scheme

Program Name: Roll Ball Mitra Yojana

Description:

Grassroots coaches trained and deployed by state associations under RBFI guidelines to conduct weekly sessions in remote and semi-urban areas.

Key Activities:

- Short-term certification courses for local youth and retired players.

• Train and deploy 2,500 grassroots Roll Ball coaches by 2026.
