Introduction

The **Roll Ball Federation of India (RBF)** is the **sole and legitimate national governing body** for the sport of Roll Ball in India. Established in 2003 and registered as a National Federation under the appropriate laws of the country, RBF has continuously and actively developed, promoted, and governed the sport across India in full alignment with the **International Roll Ball Federation (IRBF)** principles.

Legitimacy & Exclusivity

- **RBF is the only recognized national entity** responsible for the administration, regulation, and development of the sport of Roll Ball in India.
- There exists **no other organization** in India recognized by the Indian Olympic Association (IOA), the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS), or the IRBF to represent or run Roll Ball activities.
- RBF is the **founding member** of the International Roll Ball Federation (IRBF), headquartered in Pune, India, and holds the permanent seat of General Secretary for IRBF.

Working Relationships with Stakeholders

1. Government & Institutions

- Collaborates with **state education departments, municipal bodies, and youth services departments** for grassroots and school-level activities.
- Engages with **sports departments of universities** to incorporate Roll Ball into inter-collegiate sports calendars.
- Liaison with **Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports** for policy engagement and program recognition.

2. State & District Associations

- RBF has a hierarchical, federated structure with **29 State Associations** and **150+ District Units** affiliated and registered under its Constitution.
- These associations follow the RBF Bye-laws, development policies, and competition framework.
- Regular elections and governance audits ensure democratic functioning.

3. International Bodies

- RBF coordinates directly with:
 - **International Roll Ball Federation (IRBF)**
 - **Asian Roll Ball Federation**
 - **Other national federations globally** for bilateral series, knowledge exchange, and event organization.

No Competing Entity in India

- There is **no parallel or rival federation** functioning under the name of Roll Ball or any variant of the sport at a national level.
- No other entity is recognized by:

 - **Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports**

As per AIMS criteria, in the absence of any officially recognized alternative national federation, **RBF** qualifies as the sole legitimate representative for the sport in India.
