2. Core Strategic Pillars

A. Governance & Institutional Strengthening

- **Decentralized Structure**: Ensure that every state and UT has a functional, democratically elected Roll Ball association by 2026.
- **Model By-laws**: All affiliated units will follow a uniform governance structure as per RBFI Constitution in line with the IRBF charters.
- Compliance & Legal Transparency:
 - Annual financial audits.
 - RTI-compatible operations.
 - Ethics Code for all officials and technical staff.
- **Digitalization**: Implement a Roll Ball Tournament Management System (RBTMS) for player, coaches, officials, associations registration, tournament management, and licensing.
