Sub.: Report of the election of Roll Ball Federation of India (RBF) held on 20.10.2024 at Pune.

Ref.: RBF letter dated 27.9.2024 appointing the Returning Officer to conduct elections for the term 2024-28.

Dear Sir,

As per the letter dated 27.09.2024 from Roll Ball Federation of India, requesting the undersigned to be the returning officer for the Elections of the Executive Committee for the term 2024-28, I undertook the assignment. Copies of the following documents were also provided by RBF.

- (i) Notification dated 27.09.2024 for holding the Special General Body meeting and elections of Roll Ball Federation of India at Pune on 20.10.2024.
- (ii) Memorandum of Association of RBF.
- (iii) Model election guidelines prescribed in the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011.
- (iv) Electoral College.

1. Considering all these documents, the election schedule was issued on 01.10.2024 and was sent to the State and Union Territory units. While preparing the election schedule and model election guidelines due care was taken to comply with the provisions of the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011 and those in the Memorandum of Association of RBF in conduct of the elections.

2. The last date for submission of the nominations was 06.10.2024 and the list of the nominated candidates was prepared thereafter in Form-3 and displayed appropriately at the venue and was also hosted on the website. The scrutiny of nominations was done as per scheduled time and the list of the validly nominated candidates was prepared in Form-4 and was also displayed in same manner.

3. During the time period allowed for withdrawal of nominations, there was no withdrawal. Accordingly, the list of contesting candidates was prepared in Form-6 and was displayed on the notice board and the website of the federation. After the list of contesting candidates was issued, the number of candidates were either same or less as the number of posts.

4. During the Special General Body Meeting (SGM) held on 20.10.2021, I described the entire election process, the Election schedule and their compliance to the members present in the House. Since the number of candidates were same as the number of posts, voting was not required. The election results were prepared in Form-15 and was announced in the House. There were neither any complaint nor any dissatisfaction among any member present. Also, no complaints were received from any quarter with regard to the elections. Thus, the elections of RBF for the term 2024-28 were held in a free & fair manner with wide participation of members and with full

compliance of the provisions of RBFJ Memorandum of Association and those of the NSDC of India 2011, GOI.

5. I would also like to put on record my appreciation for the support and co-operation I got from the Roll Ball Federation of India without which it would not have been possible to complete this important task smoothly. I congratulated the newly elected office bearers and wished them the best for their future endeavours to take Roll Ball sport to new heights.

6. Since the election process was over I left the venue and the house took up other matters not concerning to election. This report is being sent to you for your records and further action, if any.
